**The Second Module for Online Teaching**

Dear Parent,

Greetings from Sacred Heart School, Siliguri!

At the onset, on behalf of the Management and the Teaching Community in Sacred Heart School, I thank you for your support.

This is to inform you that as per our earlier Circular No **Parents/25/2020-21**, the first module of online teaching shall be over today, i.e 11.06.20 and the second module shall be starting from 15.06.20. We shall be taking a break from academic work for 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> June and resuming from Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June. However progress in SERVICE and SKILL shall continue.

1. The results of the Second Assessment shall be uploaded in the VAWSUM shortly.
2. Please note that in the marks submitted out of 30, 20 marks is on the written assessment, 5 marks is on participation and 5 marks is on regular submission of assignment.  
Also a student is getting a credit of 10 marks each on SERVICE and SKILL.
3. In the second module, as students have not been exposed to a full length examination, a 100 marks paper shall be practiced by the students as an assignment over the period of two weeks of module 2 and students shall be given credit for their work in the Third Assessment reports.
4. SERVICE and SKILL shall be an important component of the online teaching. I request you to kindly encourage your ward to participate in that as well.
5. Also, as many students had been using their parents phone for the online classes and as many parents are now going to work, we request you that if it is possible to buy a separate device in the form of a tablet or a laptop that is neither too expensive or feature heavy for your ward's online classes. Also, an investment in a stable and fast internet connection would be a good investment.
6. Presently no decision has been taken for the restart of schools by the Government and as soon as some intimation is received from the Government, we shall be deciding on the procedure to bring back our students to school.
