**ACADEMIC PROMOTION POLICY FOR CLASSES I-X**  
**(AS PER ICSE/ISC GUIDELINES)-**

The academic policy applies to the following subjects:

**GRADE I- X**

1. English Language & English Literature
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2. 2<sup>nd</sup> Language (Hindi)
3. Social Studies (History + Geography)
4. Mathematics
5. Science (Physics+Chemistry+Biology)/Commercial Studies (GR. IX-X)
6. 6<sup>th</sup> Subject (Computer application / Economic Application /Physical Education (Gr. IX-X); Computer for Grades I to VIII
7. (Not Applicable for Grades IX & X)- Third Language
8. (Not Applicable for Grades IX & X)-General Knowledge

**GRADE I- X**

1. The pass percentage for all subjects is 40%.
1. The pass percentage for all subjects is 40%.
2. For a pass in a term examination, a student must pass in English. Failing to secure a minimum of 40% in English will earn an academic sanction.
3. For a pass in a term examination, a student must secure a minimum of 40% in Mathematics. Failure to secure 25% will earn an academic sanction.
4. A student will be considered to have failed in the term examination if he/ she fails in two subjects( For group subjects like science and social studies, the average of the group is considered)
5. Promotion is based on the average of the three terms as per the following formula- 25% of first term, 25% of second term and 50% of third term. Promotion is based on the above points-1,2,3 & 4 in the average of the three terms.
6. For a student being absent in any exam, a zero is awarded unless a genuine reason is given for the absence with a prior notice and the reason is approved by the Principal. (For such cases, re examination is not conducted but an advantage is given in the years average)

**GRADE XI-XII**

1. The pass percentage for all subjects is 40%.
1. The pass percentage for all subjects is 40%.
2. For a pass in a term examination, a student must pass in English. Failing to secure a minimum of 40% in English will earn an academic sanction.
3. The student must pass in 3 other subjects apart from English.

**In case of an academic sanction,**

1. The student has to attend the enrichment programme.
2. The child will be barred from participating in all Inter-school and inter house activities.

**THE CALCULATION FOR THE YEAR AVERAGE YEAR AVERAGE-**

**The Final Year Average is the summation of-**

1. 25% of the First Term Marks
2. 25% of the Second Term Marks
3. 50 % of the Third Term Marks

**TERM MARKS CALCULATION:**

1. **The term marks is a combination of**
  - a. continuous internal assessment for the entire term
  - b. The marks obtained in the term examination

A STUDENT WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR THE YEAR END ACADEMIC PRIZE ONLY IF THE STUDENT HAS APPEARED FOR ALL TERM END EXAMINATION AND THEIR ATTENDANCE IS ABOVE 85 %.

**Some Important Information :**

- (i) Telephone calls will be permitted on Birthdays (only on working days after 3:30pm) and on days mentioned in the events list.
- (ii) It is obligatory that every student be present on the opening day of the school after each vacation. A fine of Rs.200/- per day will be charged for those who fail to report on opening days.
- (iii) No child will be allowed to leave the school campus without parents, except in the case of emergency or with prior permission.
- (iv) Mobile phones, cameras and any other electronic gadgets are strictly prohibited.
- (v) Pocket money has to be deposited in the school office.
